Project Planning Service Public Company Limited "The Company" has established a policy for the preparation of the organization's carbon footprint to determine the amount of greenhouse gases released and absorbed by the organization. This policy also includes the preparation of a report on the organization's greenhouse gas emissions and aims to lead to actions for reducing the organization's future greenhouse gas emissions.

1. Objectives

The evaluation of the organization's carbon footprint (Carbon Footprint for Organization: CFO or Corporate Carbon Footprint: CCF) is a method used to present data on the release and absorption of greenhouse gases emitted from the organization's operations, including production and service activities. This will lead to the development of management strategies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions efficiently. It can also serve as a tool for assessing greenhouse gas emissions and enhancing the company's capabilities, while preparing for situations where the government may require organizations to report their greenhouse gas emissions and absorption (Greenhouse Gas Reporting). The purpose is to manage greenhouse gas emissions in alignment with national greenhouse gas management policies.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all operational processes within the company. It involves assessing and collecting data on greenhouse gas emissions and absorption within the organization's operational control.

3. Authority, Responsibilities, and Accountability for Carbon Footprint Management

- 1) Promote and support employees in managing the company's critical resources, ensuring that all levels of staff understand, cooperate, and work together to achieve excellence in management, thereby building trust with shareholders, stakeholders, and clients.
- 2) Encourage and develop employees at all levels to access information sources on methods for reducing greenhouse gases, as well as organizing the carbon footprint reporting system.
- 3) Collect relevant greenhouse gas emission data from the organization's activities to evaluate the amount of greenhouse gases released and absorbed.

4) Policy Review

The Board of Directors will review and approve the policy in case of any changes.
